Specifically, GAO reviewed the contrasts and similarities among the systems and identified foreign pay policies or practices which offered the potential for use by the United States in countering All-Volunteer Force manpower problems. In its review, GAO found that the military compensation system of the United States differs from the compensation systems of other countries in the manner in which it undertakes to satisfy personal living requirements with goods, services, and facilities, and in the way it compensates according to marital and dependency status. Australia, Canada, the United Kingdom, and the United States maintain their armed forces on a volunteer basis. The three foreign countries, however, have discarded pay and allowances structures similar to those of the U.S. system in favor of a taxable salary system. In Australia and the United Kingdom, the taxable salary system also includes an X factor paid to servicemen to compensate for the disadvantages and rigors of military life.
